India's First's in Philately (After Independence) continued....

First Stamps Printed in Photogravure Process were issued on 1st October 1952 commemorating the Indian Saints and Poets in the denominations of 6ps, 1A, 2As, 4As, 4½As & 12As. Till then all stamps were printed by offset-litho process only. Till today all the stamps are being printed in Photogravure Process only.

First Stamp on Stamp was issued on 23rd December 1970 in the denomination of 20p to commemorate India National Philatelic Exhibition 1970. Stamp on stamp is normally issued to commemorate stamp exhibitions, stamp centenary, any incident remembering the printing techniques or process or founders of stamps, postal systems, machinery for stamp printing, stamp dealing companies etc. This is an excellent topic for thematic collection.



First Stamp on Stamp

First Coin / Medallion on Stamp was issued on 14th November 1964 commemorating National Children's Day, the birthday of Pundit Jawaharlal Nehru. The design in the centre is mentioned as a medal in literatures. But this design was adopted as the reverse of the 50 paise coin and
